



Regarding: 6Pack Volleyball Leagues

The following information provides you with the necessary tools to help ensure that we have a successful re-launch of 6Pack's Volleyball Leagues. As many of you are aware, the Provincial Health Orders now requires businesses to check Vaccine Cards prior to entry.

We respect everyone's right to choose their own stance on this matter, but please understand that we are obligated to put the required mandate into effect in order for our facility to stay open. Due to the pandemic, a number of rules, procedures, and policies have been updated so your support for these will go a long way towards ensuring that we are able to continue playing as we progress to manage the implications of the Covid19 virus.

COVID-19 Protocols

Our staff members will be enforcing the new restrictions and we ask that everyone be patient and kind. We are not in a position to be able to continue operations without following the new law and order. Face masks are required when entering the facility and when using the common areas such as the lobby, reception, foyer, washrooms, and change rooms, but are optional during game play on the sand.

By entering the facility and participating in the beach activities you accept the City of Richmond's Covid-19 Risk Acknowledgement. Details can be found on the City of Richmond's website at www.richmond.ca/covid19.

Screening of Vaccination Passports:

Due to the proof of vaccination requirements from the Provincial Health Officer we require all adults participating in activities to show visual proof of vaccination AND government photo ID before entering the common areas. This will be conducted for at least the first week of leagues. You need both pieces to enter the facility. IF you forget one or the other, you will be denied entry.

BC Vaccine Card with unique QR code (digital version on Smartphone or tablet, or paper copy) AND a piece of valid government photo ID to match the name on the BC Vaccine Card. For example:

- **BC driver's licence or BC Services Card**
- **Passport**
- **Photo ID issued by another province or territory**

To help speed up the screening processes please have your documents ready before you check in at the front desk reception. Screening will occur prior to game start time. Game start time will not be delayed so please allow extra time to be screened.

To make the screening process more efficient we ask that you provide written consent that you have been properly vaccinated and screened and to have that information stored in our database. That way our staff do not have to keep screening you each time upon entering the facility.

No Spectators:

At this time, we must follow the rules of no spectators allowed in the facility. If you are eating and drinking at Court6 Cafe then you are a patron of the cafe and not a spectator.

Substitutes:

Team captains are responsible for substitutes. Please advise the subs that they will be going through the Covid19 screening process. It is best advised to have the same subs playing for the team each time. All Covid19 procedures will apply to substitutes.

Anyone who disregards these rules will be asked to leave, may lose playing privileges, and forfeit their registration fees.

If everyone can do their part and adhere to the rules, we stand a good chance of being able to keep our leagues running and complete the season.
